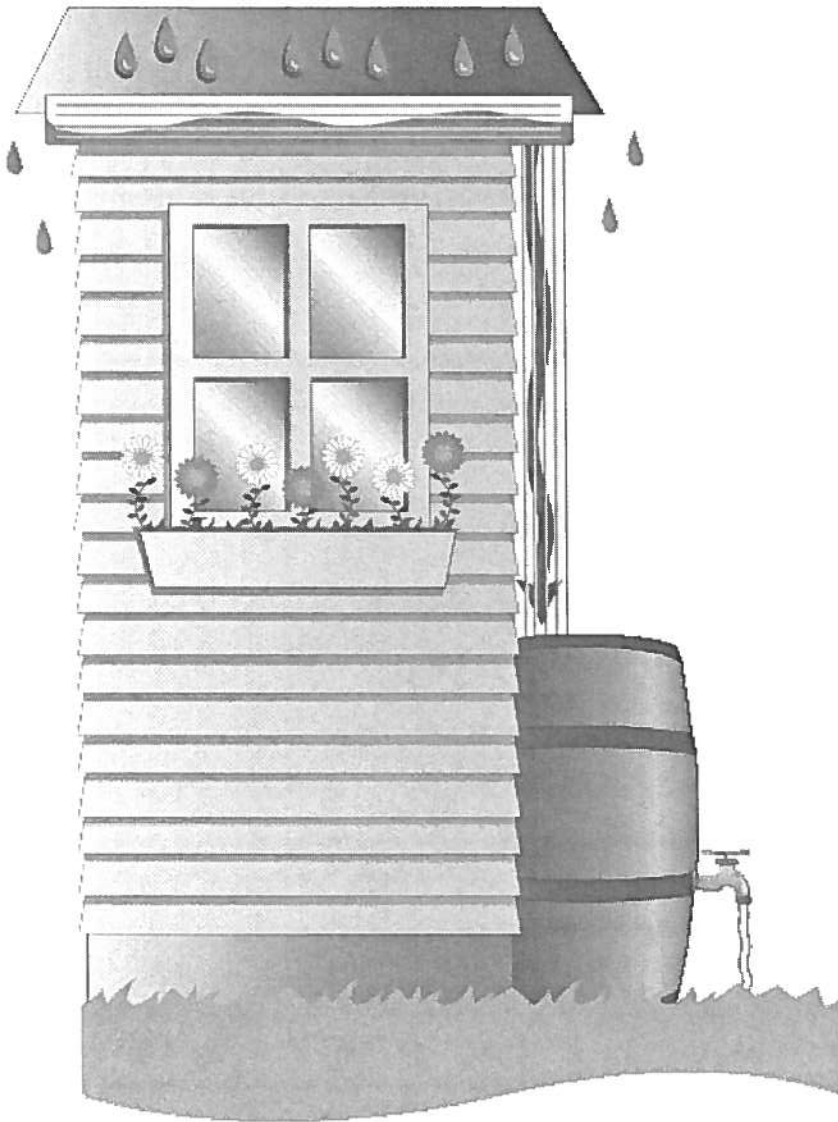




“Make and Take”

RAIN BARREL WORKSHOP

Participants will learn the ins and outs of rain barrels and build their own rain barrel for immediate use.

Rain barrels harvest rainwater, which can then be used to irrigate gardens and landscape plants. In turn, they help reduce the amount of fertilizer and pesticides that are carried off site by storm water runoff and prevent non-point source pollution in our lakes, rivers, and streams.
